

Program Associated Costs

The following are estimated costs of the Internship program.

Tuition	\$7000 (Interns have the option of splitting the tuition into two payments due in August and January-payable by cashier's check, money order, or VISA/Mastercard)

Immunizations Variable cost dependent on what immunizations interns have to date

Interns of the Baptist Health System are eligible for student loan deferment. Interns are issued a letter outlining internship program requirements and indicating full time student status.

Non- Degree interns are not eligible for federal financial aid through enrollment in the internship program. Interns on the Graduate Degree track and enrolled in the University of Houston are eligible for federal financial aid.

Interns are encouraged to apply for scholarship opportunities from their local and state dietetic associations as well as the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics
